“Aminah Brenda Lynn Robinson: Character Studies”

When she died in 2015, Aminah Brenda Lynn Robinson left her artwork and personal effects to the Columbus Museum of Art in Ohio, and it established the Aminah Robinson Legacy Project, which funds fellowships for African American artists and the conservation of her home and studio. Fort Gansevoort aims to support these endeavors through the sale of pieces from the estate in collaboration with the museum.
